Submission Guidelines

1. Students must use Arial font and a font size of 11. Entries must be submitted in pdf as well as MS word format.
2. The papers should not exceed ten A-4 size pages and should be sent to the IAStructE Secretariat at iastructe@gmail.com along with the Student(s) Profile (should be submitted in "Microsoft Word" format). Student (s) profile should also include address for postal communication, name of the college, email address, photograph, phone numbers. Student profile should be in maximum 200 words. If more than one author is there, then each author can have 200 words profile and it should to be submitted in a single document.
3. The technical paper, duly endorsed by the Head of the Department, along with a letter from the HOD should be sent by email as well as hard copy.
4. Papers approved by panel of judges will be published in the Annual Journal or Newsletter or Website of IAStructE.
5. Only one technical paper per student shall be permitted. Submission of more than one entry will lead to disqualification.
6. Incomplete Entries (as per the guidelines) and those received after the last date will not be considered.
7. The decision of the Panel of Judges shall be final and no appeal against it shall be entertained.

PLAGIARISM: The author is responsible for clearance from his/her organization as well as permission to reproduce any figure, table and text previously published by others. By submitting a manuscript, the author certifies that neither the manuscript nor any portion of it is copyrighted. Papers will undergo plagiarism check and papers found to be plagiarized will be rejected.
